7.1.9 Sensitization of students and employees of the Institution to the constitutional obligations: values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens

Describe the various activities in the Institution for inculcating values for being responsible citizens as reflected in the Constitution of India within 500 words.

Celebration of Constitution day is done on 26 November every year. An organizing committee is set up to conduct activities to sensitize the students. As per the direction of authorities' celebration begin with reading of the preamble by Principal, staff and students. Reading the preamble followed by oath reaffirms commitment to upholding its ideology. Further Principal contextualizes the importance of celebrating the Constitution day. Features of constitution and its relevance in present day are discussed by the teachers of Political Science Department. A cheerful ambience is established among the students and staff and the zeal of celebration is clearly apparent. Debate, extempore, essay writing, chart making, Rangoli etc. competitions are held to raise the excitement. Preamble, fundamental Duties and picture of constitution hall is displayed in college corridors. Unity march is taken out by the students of NCC and NSS.

National flag is hoisted by the Principal every year on Independence Day and Republic day. National Anthem is sung by all students and Staff. NCC cadets carry out parade to salute the national flag. Cultural programs are organized on the theme of patriotism. Freedom fighters and leaders are commemorated in speech. National Unity day is observed on 31 October with an aim to understand the sovereignty and integrity of India and contribution of the Iron man, SardarVallabhbhaiPatel towards the unification of our nation during the time of India's Freedom.

Cultural plurality is celebrated in the form of Chhattisgarhi traditional and folk dance like *Panthei, Sua, Dadariya*. Even during the annual gatherings patriotic themes are assigned for the performance of dance, drama or song representation. BasantPanchami is celebrated with full gaiety. In Anandmela students cook Chhattisgarh state's representative cuisines. National integration is taught in the syllabus of NCC. NSS camps also teach spirit of harmony and selfless social

service to village people. Programs related with Gender equity is organized where students learn to respect Women and offer help to the needy.

SwachhataAbhiyan and Pakhwadas are observed every year at college, nearby places, and adopted villages by NSS. Statues of national leaders in the locality, places of historical and cultural value like the Pataleshwar temple and garden of Malhar is cleaned by the NCC cadets. Safeguarding of public and college property is taught to new students during orientation program. Yoga day is observed and cherished with a sense of pride. During the parent teacher meet people of village community are taught the importance and relevance of literacy so that every child gets the right to study and thereby they do not drop out after failure. To promote Technological advancement computer courses like PGDCA, BCA and DCA are offered to village students. Self-funding PG courses in Science are started for the benefit of these students.
